## Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Mayor Anthony DaPrato.

# **Reading of Minutes**

Motion by Ball to approve meeting minutes from April 7th, 2025, with corrections, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Moeller, motion carried.

# **Public Comment**

Dan Pickering stated he did not receive a bill in the mail. His water was disconnected for nonpayment. Discussion that City bills are always due on the 10<sup>th</sup> of every month. He has since signed up for autopay and would like his \$50.00 reconnection fee waived. Motion by Lister to waive Dan Pickering's \$50.00 reconnection fee now that he has autopay, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Moeller, motion carried.

#### **Park Committee**

CWC Electric submitted a bid for \$101,550.00 and then lowered it to \$98,900 with different light fixtures. The council had questions about using solar lights. No action was taken, investigating solar lighting.

There has been confusion on the walking path. Maintenance is being told to go ahead and then being told to stop by different council members and committee members.

#### Resolution #2025-2

Motion by Ball to adopt Resolution 2025-2, a resolution regarding the appointment of a park committee, and the appointment of a steering committee for the park committee for the city of Carbondale, Kansas, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Moeller, motion carried.

#### **Maintenance**

Jon passed his wastewater examination.

Maintenance did a survey of street signs. There are 18 stop signs, two 20mph, two 40 mph and 18 additional signs that need to be replaced. All replacement stop signs should be 30x30. Motion by Ball to purchase 18 stop signs not to exceed \$1,200, 2<sup>nd</sup> by K. Seals, motion carried.

2005 Chevy Diesel has 171,000 miles on it and needs \$4,570.42 in repairs to make it safe. Motion by Ball to approve Maintenance to get the 2005 Chevy repaired at Carbondale Tire and Auto in the amount of \$4,570.42, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Seals, motion carried.

Discussion on maintenance shop door being broken. Maintenance will get council an additional repair price so that the auto opener will work.

# Fish Feeder

Motion by Moeller to hire Tyler Beckman for 2025 Fish Feeder at Strobridge Reservoir/ Carbondale East Lake at the bid price of \$13 per hour for repairs and \$200 weekly lump sum, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Moeller, discussion on repairs, motion carried.
