


Your Street Will Be **CLOSED**



Sorry to inconvenience you, but your street is scheduled for Slurry Sealing on the date shown between 8:00 am and 6:00 pm

ALL CARS MUST BE OFF THE STREET BY 8:00 A.M.

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SLURRY SEAL	Slurry Seal is a mixture of liquid asphalt and gravel that is spread over asphalt streets to extend the life of the roadway. The Slurry Seal process will not leave loose gravel on the surface. Some areas may be covered with sand to protect the new seal coat.
ON DATE ABOVE	All cars need to be off the street by 8:00 a.m. CARS NOT MOVED WILL BE TOWED to a nearby street out of the way of construction work. Please have all automatic watering devices turned-off the evening before the date shown above. Residents shall avoid throwing grass clippings onto street prior to beginning work.
IN CASE OF RAIN	Slurry Seal work will be postponed by rain. Work may start on the first day of dry weather without any additional notice. If the work is not completed in one (1) day, both lanes of the street will be open overnight, and the work will continue the next morning at 8:00 am.
TRAFFIC AND DRIVEWAY ACCESS	The street WILL be closed during the day. There will be access at all times in case of emergency. WE RECOMMEND YOU AVOID THE CONSTRUCTION AREAS. Parking on adjacent streets is recommended during the daytime. Parking in driveways is recommended if you DO NOT plan on moving the vehicle during the daytime hours. The new seal coat contains oil that can damage the finish on your car or stain surfaces such as concrete, carpet or flooring when tracked from the construction areas. If you drive or walk through a posted construction area, YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE for any damage to your vehicle or property.
